
Pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), I hereby request the following:

*All records including but not limited to emails, legal opinions, letters, memoranda, and position papers discussing the legal and policy implications of posting online or otherwise making public documents seized from the government of Iraq in 2003. Documents were available on the Foreign Military Studies Office Joint Reserve Intelligence Center website - Operation Iraqi Freedom Documents.*

If you regard any of these documents as potentially exempt from the FOIA's disclosure requirements, I request that you nonetheless exercise your discretion to disclose them. As the FOIA requires, please release all reasonably segregable non-exempt portions of documents. To permit me to reach an intelligent and informed decision whether or not to file an administrative appeal of any denied material, please describe any withheld records (or portions thereof) and explain the basis for your exemption claims.

As a representative of the news media, the National Security Archive qualifies for "representative of the news media" status under 5 U.S.C. Sec. 552(a)(4)(A)(ii)(II) and, therefore, may not be charged search and review fees. (See *National Security Archive v. U.S. Department of Defense*, 880 F.2d 1361 (D.C. Cir. 1989), cert denied, 110 S.Ct. 1478 (1990)). This request is made as part of a scholarly and news research project that is intended for publication and is not for commercial use.
