

Full Translation

1,200,000,000—praise God, Comforter of His custodians. This is the testimony of the enemies. One of the unbelievers' broadcasts on BBC mentioned, a year after the events, that 120,000 Americans converted to Islam. After this year they haven't mentioned anything about this subject (may God humiliate them).

God said, "It is He Who got out the Unbelievers among the People of the Book from their homes at the first gathering (of the forces). Little did ye think that they would get out: And they thought that their fortresses would defend them from God. But the (Wrath of) God came to them from quarters from which they little expected (it)" (TN: Qur'an 59:2).

In this verse, both the faithful and the unbelievers were thinking about their strength, their economy, their machines, and their equipment. But God prevails over His affairs. God said, "but if it had been God's Will, He could certainly have exacted retribution from them (Himself); but (He lets you fight) in order to test you, some with others" (TN: Qur'an 47:4), so that He can distinguish between the wicked and the righteous. God said, "God will not leave the believers in the state in which ye are now, until He separates what is evil from what is good" (TN: Qur'an 3:179), but to weigh the evidence against His servants and show mercy to the unbelievers. God said, "Do then those who devise evil (plots) feel secure that God will not cause the earth to swallow them up, or that the Wrath will not seize them from directions they little perceive? Or that He may not call them to account in the midst of their goings to and fro, without a chance of their frustrating Him? Or that He may not call them to account by a process of slow wastage - for thy Lord is indeed full of kindness and mercy" (TN: Qur'an 16:45-47). Glory to God, for he is able to seize them in a moment, but He has mercy on them out of fear of impairing them, one after another, so that, in time, they can come under His mercy. The seal of the verses is that your Lord is merciful and compassionate. Glory to God—the Prophet brought the good news that he was His supporter. God said, "If any think that God will not help him (His Apostle, in this world and the Hereafter, let him stretch out a rope to the ceiling and cut (himself) off:

then let him see whether his plan will remove that which enrages
(him)! (TN: Qur'an 22:15).
