



## **Tamara A. Johnson** Principal Deputy Inspector General

Tamara Johnson was named Principal Deputy Inspector General of the Intelligence Community in October 2020. In this capacity, Ms. Johnson is responsible for providing daily management, oversight, and direction of Office of the Inspector General of the Intelligence Community (IC IG) activities and the management of personnel. With more than a decade of service at the Office of the Director of National Intelligence (ODNI) and almost two decades supporting the Intelligence Community (IC), ten of those in the Inspector General community, Ms. Johnson has a strong track record of leading collaboratively across the IC to drive the design, stand up, and evolution of intelligence community operations while fostering a culture of workforce engagement and professional development.

Ms. Johnson's professional accomplishments include serving as the IC IG's Assistant Inspector General for Planning and Operations and the Assistant Inspector General for Management and Administration from 2012 to 2020. In both positions, she managed the overall operation of the office and helped drive support service innovation. Other prior assignments include Chief of Staff for the ODNI Office of the Inspector General, Executive Officer for the CIA Directorate of Support, Non-Traditional Support Program, and Branch Chief for the ODNI Facilities Programming and Space Management Branch.

Ms. Johnson began her career in private industry in the Interior Architecture field where she spent 14 years providing design and construction management services to clients in the government, legal, and association sectors. She later joined Booz Allen as a senior management consultant supporting clients in the areas of strategy development, operations, and organizational change management.

Ms. Johnson was appointed to the Senior National Intelligence Service in May 2015.
