### Office of the Inspector General of the Intelligence Community Launches Redesigned Websites

**(February 7, 2019)** The Office of the Inspector General of the Intelligence Community (ICIG) has redesigned its secure and [unclassified](#) websites to provide visitors with more information and easier site navigation.

Site improvements support IC Inspector General Michael K. Atkinson's objectives to:

- Increase transparency into the ICIG's oversight activities;
- Raise workforce awareness about duties, processes, and protections associated with reporting fraud, waste, and abuse; and
- Enhance communication, coordination, and collaboration among inspector general partners.

Simplified menus list targeted informational categories, beginning with an introduction to the ICIG's [statutory authorities](#), [leadership](#), [divisions and offices](#), and [FAQs](#), followed by an overview of [Intelligence Community Whistleblowing](#) programs. A tab for the ICIG [Hotline](#) provides a comprehensive list of reporting channels, and clarifies the complaint types best addressed by each oversight office.

A News section features [ICIG News](#) about recent events, activities, reports, and announcements pertaining to coming audits, inspections, and reviews. It also highlights outreach activities showcasing stakeholder, partner, and workforce engagements.

The [Publications](#) menu links to unclassified and classified ICIG [Reports](#), provides guidance about [Freedom of Information Act](#) requests, and offers readers access to the first time released ICIG's [Annual Work Plan for Fiscal Year 2019](#). The plan identifies the ICIG's mandatory, as well as discretionary, assessments for the upcoming year.

Other key offerings include [Careers](#), Training, and [Partnerships](#), which describe ICIG responsibilities and activities related to the [Intelligence Community Inspectors General Forum](#), the [Council of the Inspectors General on Integrity and Efficiency](#), and the Five Eyes Intelligence Oversight and Review Council.

The ICIG's secure site also features a registration link to the Intelligence Community Inspectors General Conference scheduled for March 28, 2019, at the National Geospatial-Intelligence Headquarters in Springfield, Virginia. The one-day conference addresses key topics in the IG community, including unauthorized disclosures, whistleblowing, cryptocurrency, making better use of data, and presenting matters to prosecutors. Visitors should note that registration closes March 15.
