
Your request was processed in accordance with the FOIA, 5 U.S.C. § 552, as amended. A thorough search of our records and databases located one document responsive to your request. Upon review, it is determined the document must withheld in its entirety pursuant to FOIA exemptions (b)(1), and (b)(3). FOIA exemption (b)(1), protects information that is currently and properly classified and FOIA exemption (b)(3), protects information that is specifically covered by statute. The relevant withholding statute is the National Security Act of 1947, as amended, 50 U.S.C. § 3024(i)(1), which protects information pertaining to intelligence sources and methods.
